Last spring, you will recall, the ITCA conducted a vote among members for judges for our 1977 Specialties. The seven who received the most votes were, in order, Ellsworth Gamble, Phyllis Haage, Joan Elliott, Robert Peters, Anne Rogers Clark, Michael Gately and John Marvin. Your Secretary is now engaged in securing the Specialty judges on the basis of this list. They will be announced as soon as we receive AKC approval for our choices.

The remainder of this Bulletin will be devoted to the various Irish Terrier Specialties of 1976. Detailed results of those that have already been held will be found on the concluding pages. Starting with the most recent, and working back:

ITCA Traveling Specialty, June 20

ITC Southern California Specialty, June 19

Our 2nd annual Traveling Specialty was held June 20 at Culver City, CA. It was a decided success, thanks to the months of work of Show Chairman Marion Honey and her committee, and to the cooperation of the ITC Southern California which held its annual Specialty the previous day at the same location.

William L. Kendrick judged an entry of 31 (only one absentee), which included Midwestern and Eastern as well as Western dogs.

The show was held in conjunction with the Kennel Club of Beverly Hills, on the athletic field of West Los Angeles College, in Culver City.

Best of Breed was CH. SANSFIELD SPACEMAN (Carlotta Howard). Best Opposite Sex, Winners Bitch and Best of Winners was ROCKLEDGE'S NORAH ANN (Marion Honey) from the 6-9 months Puppy class. Winner Dog was MULLAGHBOY BOUNTY TYRUS (Lorraine and James Reed).

The ITC Southern California Specialty the day before, June 19, was part of the Great Western Terrier Specialties, with Mrs. Grace Brewin judging an entry of 27, one absentee. Again, it was Carlotta Howard's CH. SANSFIELD SPACEMAN taking Best of Breed. BOS was Ellis West's CH. GLOCCOMARA CENTRIFUGAL MAMA. WD and BOW was the Reeds' MULLAGHBOY BOUNTY TYRUS, and WB was Pat Casey's MULLAGHBOY BAD'n BEAUTIFUL. Members of the ITCSC served up a delightful luncheon at noon, prepared by them.

Marion Honey worked closely with Betty and John Tebbetts, President and Ex-President respectively of the ITCSC, in coordinating plans for the two shows. Informal Irish Terrier headquarters for the weekend was the Howard Johnson motel nearby. The motel provided two adjoining rooms to serve as a hospitality suite, which proved to be highly satisfactory, convenient and well-frequented. Members provided a stock of refreshments. The Irish Terrier crowd had a dinner at the motel on Saturday night. Out-of-state attendees at the two shows included Cory Klemperer from Washington State, the Caseys and Munroes from Arizona, and Ellis West from Kansas. Margaret and Rocky Stone and Dian Martin drove down from ITC Northern California territory. If a prize had been offered for the exhibitor traveling from the farthest point it surely would have gone to Phyllis Kendrick, who motored from Massachusetts with half a dozen Irish Terriers, a Lakeland, and a cat, stopping off enroute at Grayslake, Illinois, to win a BOS at the ITC Chicago Specialty. Phyllis is herewith invited to write us something about her transcontinental adventures.

ITC Chicago Specialty - June 12.

This Specialty, at Grayslake, was held as usual with the Great Lakes Terrier Association, Inc. Mike Gately judged an entry of 21 (2 absent). Best of Breed was DAYSPRING'S DOCTOR PEPPER (James Ryan). BOS was CH. GREENCASTLE'S POOKE OF BAMBA (Phyllis Kendrick). WD was DONNYBROOK'S RED RASCAL (P. Casey), and WB and BOW was DENBRYL'S BRUMMY (Dennis Barnes).

Next day at the Chain O' Lakes show at the same grounds, John Best's BLACKACRE BARON made the difficult ascent from Puppy class to Best of Breed, under Judge Thelma R. Brown. BOS was Pat Casey's MULLAGHBOY BAD'n BEAUTIFUL from the Open class. There were 18 entered.

The two shows drew a good geographical representation. On Saturday night, following the Specialty, 33 attended a dinner at the Northern Chalet, Libertyville, after which the Club held its annual meeting.

Looking to the future, ITC Chicago will hold its Match on August 15, at Grayslake. Gary Johnson will come down from Minneapolis to judge. The ITC Chicago will support the entry at the Chicago International show, where the usual Club dinner is planned to be held. Finally, this is an appropriate place to repeat that the ITCA 1977 Traveling Specialty will be held June 19 at Grayslake at the Chain O' Lakes show (decision of the ITCA Board of Governors at its meeting last February in New York). As usual, the ITC Chicago will hold its Specialty the day before at the same location.

ITC Northern California - August 8.

The ITCNC will hold its annual Specialty on August 8 at the Cow Palace in San Francisco, in conjunction with the Golden Gate K.C. summer show. Judge will be Mrs. Charles Marck (a former ITCA member before she began a judging career). Margaret Stone and Diana Martin are taking care of arrangements for the show. The Northern California club will hold its annual meeting shortly thereafter, August 10, following a barbecue dinner at Dennis Sheehan's home.

ITC New York - September 26.

The ITC New York annual Specialty will be held as usual with the Westbury K.A. show, on Sunday, September 26, one week before the ITCA Fall Specialty in Pennsylvania. Mrs. Augustus Riggs IV will judge. Gregor Hetzel is Show Chairman, assisted by Nancy Hetzel (trophies) and Horace Clark (advertising).

ITCA Fall Specialty - October 3.

Finally, the ITCA annual Fall Specialty. Date: October 3. Place: Temple University Music Festival grounds at Ambler, PA. (as last year). Host Club: Montgomery County K.C. Judge: Nick Calicura.

Show Chairman is Marie Johnson. Her committee comprises: Nancy and Greg Hetzel - hospitality; R. J. Koepfel - trophies; James P. Kelley - advertising; and Portia Campbell - publicity.

A feature of this year's Fall Specialty will be a Sweepstakes, to be judged by June Kennedy. A dinner is being planned for the Saturday night before the Specialty at the Valley Forge Holiday Inn at King of Prussia, where we have met for the past several years. Details will be provided later.

Nancy Hetzel requests that anyone possessing any Irish Terrier-oriented slides suitable for showing after the dinner please let her know so that she and Greg can arrange for a projector and screen.

Marie Johnson tells us that contributions to the trophy fund can still be made, up until August 1. If you haven't already contributed and wish to do so, please send your check, made out to the Irish Terrier Club of America, to R.J. Koepfel, P.O. Box 211, Rock Island, IL 61201. Marie also suggests that this Bicentennial year is a good time to get out and see the country, especially the area of Valley Forge and Philadelphia at ITCA Fall Specialty time. (Right on!)
