### VETERAN EXPERT TO JUDGE 1950 SPECIALTY

Edwin A. ("Pop") Sayres will serve as judge at the club's annual Specialty Show, to be held Sunday, February 12, 1950, in the 12th Regiment Armory, Columbus Ave. and 62d Street, New York City, in conjunction with the 29th annual Associated Terrier Clubs' event. Unanimous choice of I. T. C. A. officials, Mr. Sayres' selection has been approved by the American Kennel Club, and what remains is the task of providing him with an entry of the size and quality his reputation and experience deserve.

Nobody in this country knows the requisites of a good Mick better than "Pop" Sayres, and the reasons for that knowledge are obvious. Over a long period of years he has bred and shown and studied them. A terrier man by profession and a handler of many of the "greats" of the past, he will bring to the analysis of his placings that experience which is gained only through a lifetime of actually doing the conditioning job. Exhibitors at the 1950 Specialty should consider it a privilege to have their entries evaluated by one so thoroughly competent.
