Hold everything! The site for the ITCA Fall Specialty has been changed again.

Our July BULLETIN said the show would be held at the Rohm and Haas Co., near Spring House, Pa. Cancel that. The Montgomery County KC, which gives the show, has announced that because of extensive road construction near the proposed grounds, another site in the same neighborhood has been engaged; namely, the Temple University Music Festival grounds, near Ambler, Pa. These grounds are about a mile from the Rohm and Haas plant, and three miles from last year's site at Penllyn.

John Marvin, Montgomery County KC show chairman, speaking of the Temple University Music Festival grounds said: "They are simply tremendous. We have beautiful grass, about 10 acres, and best yet, a paved parking area for about 3,000 cars."

Mr. Marvin gave the following directions for getting there:

From the south and/or Pennsylvania Turnpike: leave the Turnpike at Exit 26 (Rte 309 expressway). Go north on 309 about two miles to the Susquehanna exit, turn left to Butler Avenue, then turn right to the show grounds.

From the north: leave Rte 309 at Butler Avenue exit, turn right, go about two blocks to the show grounds.

Should anyone wish a Premium List for the Fall Specialty, please let me know.

Specialty exhibitors should not overlook the two unbenched shows nearby on the two previous days: October 6, Hatboro Dog Club, at Horshan, Pa., and October 7, the Devon Dog Show Association, at Devon, Pa. Foley's is superintendent for both of these shows.
